RE: G3 Elite Sports 7v7 Rules

- G3 Elite Sports 7v7 Tournaments use Zorts Sports. All Teams playing in our tournaments must sign up and obtain a Zorts Card for each Player and Coach. There will be no exceptions. If a player or Coach shows up without being on the team's roster registered in Zorts for our tournament, they will not be permitted to play or Coach. Payments for Teams will not be accepted at the tournament site, nor will any player be allowed to sign up for a Zorts Card and be permitted to play in that tournament.
- At G3 Elite Sports, we expect that each Coach, Player, Parent, and Spectator will professionally conduct themselves at all times. Remember, we are here for the kids, and G3 Elite Sports holds itself and shall hold all others to this standard.
- There are no Firearms, Drugs, or alcohol permitted in or around any G3 Elite Sports event. All rules and enforcements per facility or location will be strictly enforced and followed. If any of these are broken or brought on-site, law enforcement will immediately take over the situation.
- G3 Elite Sports asks that backpacks for spectators be clear and able to be seen through; if a backpack is brought and does not in these requirements, it will be subject to a search. If the party with the backpack does not allow or consent to the search they will be asked to leave the tournament.
- Any fight or physical altercation will not be tolerated. If any of these occur or have the feel that they may occur, the parties involved will immediately be escorted off the premises, accompanied by Law Enforcement Officials. (If this occurs with Coaches or Players, they will be held to the same enforcement policy and reported to Zorts Sports, where they could lose their ability to participate in any Zorts platform tournaments.)
- G3 Elite Sports shall not be responsible for any items lost or stolen. Any gear or items remaining will be placed in our lost and found located at the G3 Elite Sports Merchandise tent and can be claimed there. If items are not claimed, they will remain with G3 Elite Sports and can be claimed by contacting us at g3elitesports.com through the tournament director's email. All shipping costs will be charged to the losing party, and no cost to G3 Elite Sports.
- If there are any questions or concerns during tournament play, please contact the G3 Elite Sports Tournament Director. All questions and concerns will be addressed promptly and in a timely, professional manner.

- G3 Elite Sports 7v7 Tournaments allow for three Coaches per Team on the sideline; only one Coach may be in the offensive huddle. Defensively, we do not allow any Coaches to be inside the field of play at any time.
- G3 Elite Sports 7v7 Tournament games will have a 20-minute running clock. Each team will be allotted one time-out per game. The clock does not stop for any reason other than a time-out. The allotted time for the time given during time-out will be determined by the Officials and shall not exceed one minute.
- Each offensive play will have a 4-second timer, clock will start on ball movement. Each offensive team will have a designated snapper who must align on a knee.
- Each game will have a 2-minute warning, and there will be a clock stoppage for 30 seconds.
- All games will be scored as a standard football game, with a choice of 2 or 1 point conversions after a score. At G3 Elite Sports 7v7, we will play what we call the G3 Ball. This allows for the offensive team to select once per game for a possible 10-point score, plus an extra point choice. This G3 Ball also allows the defensive team to double their points for stops, Interceptions, and picks.
- G3 Elite Sports 7v7 awards the defense 2 points for a stop, 3 points for an Interception with a pick 6 opportunity. If the defense scores on an Interception, the intercepting team has an opportunity for an extra point.
- Each team will have a 1 blitz opportunity per game. (Teams will not be permitted to blitz from the 40-yard line.)
- Players are permitted to play up for teams; however, the team that the player is registered with is the only team the player shall be allowed to play with. (*There will be no exceptions to this rule.*)
- Each player division will play with the regulation ball for that age group. G3 Elite Sports does allow for a team to play with the upper regulation ball but does not permit any smaller regulation balls in age divisions. Any team that in violation of this rule will have a penalty assessed of 10 yards.
- We at G3 Elite Sports ask that each of our vendors, sponsors, or partners be treated and respected at all times. If any concerns with any vendors, sponsors, or partners, please bring them to the attention of the G3 Elite Sports Tournament Director.

- After our tournaments, there will be a trophy and ring ceremony for each age division Champion. Team pictures and videos will be taken along with player and coach interviews. We at G3 Elite Sports ask that all parties professionally conduct themselves, as we will promote and post these videos to showcase your team and organization. As champion of our tournaments your team and organization will be highlighted on our champions page for all to see.
